Overview

Task

Write out your success and challenge somewhere on your map.

Quality Process

- As individuals, silently on where you are in your learning journey. Make notes of where you've been and where you are right now.
- In teams, co-construct your system's journey using the systems signs.
- Make notes of specifics in order to help others understand more clearly your specific steps.
- Decide on what success or problem of practice you will share.
- During protocol, be active and present.

- Notes on sequence signs are helpful in explaining specific steps.
